Played with some clear tone, but it lacked essential buoyancy and shape, with some lapses in control and need for quite a lot more overall vitality. It had the notes though, with some dynamic variety at one point.		
Chee-Hwa Tan: The Swing (from Through the Windowpane)		25 /30
There was some gentleness and sostenuto here, finding some of the mood, but there might have been more shape and dynamic variety earlier. It became more expressive later though, with a good change of colour latterly.		
Pam Wedgwood: The Detective (No. 6 from Up-Grade! Piano Grades		26 /30
1–2)		
The line was well sustained, with some resonance, but there was room for more expressive contouring and expansion to more fully find the mood. Musical even so, with a good accuracy and steadiness.		
Scales and broken chords		19 /21
The scales were good, but there might have been more shape and overall vitality. The arpeggios were both excellent today.		
Sight-reading		18 /21
The important F sharp was overlooked, with room for more dynamics, but it was otherwise a good and largely rhythmic reading.

Not correct on the metre, with some echo imprecisions, but this was still a strong overall response.
